

## How to Appeal Your Results on the Hunter College Mathematics Placement Test

If you believe your math placement is not on target, that is, you know more than what you showed on the MPT, you can submit an appeal to the Coordinator of the Course in which you wish to register. For students who take the MPT after February 1, there are typically free 2-week summer immersion workshops in mid-July that provide refreshers, with an opportunity to move up to the next course in the sequence. You do need to know what course you want to take next. Once you know the course, you should appeal directly to the course coordinator below.

Fill out the **Appeal Form (see page 2)**, and return with a copy of your high school transcript and any college transcript that shows math coursework. Attach all documents as pdf format files in an email to the appropriate course coordinator below:
